

ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORT OF THE TRUST MARKAZ-E-ADAB-O-SCIENCE, RANCHI

Year – 2011-2012

1. The Present strength of students in different courses in all the four institutes are as follows:-
 - i) IGNOU MBA ,MCA,BCA and CIT : 325
 - ii) NCPUL One Year DCA/DTP Course at SCTGC, Bariatu: 99
 - iii) NCPUL One Year DCA/DTP Course at SIIT, Kantatoli : 91
 - iv) DOEACC Free Computer Course for SC,ST & Minorities: 109
 - v) ECIL-ECIT Free Computer Course for Minorities: 50
 - vi) Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) : 165
2. A Power Point Presentation was presented in front of 27th meeting of IDB Central Panel, held in Hotel Mauraya, Patna on 29th March 2011 for the financial assistance for the construction of a residential school project of the Trust from Special Assistance Programme of IDB. The project was in principal approved by the central panel and put into the pipe line.
3. Trust organised the Islamic Development Bank (IDB) Scholarship Pre-Selection Seminar & Interview (PSI) with the collaboration of Muslim Education Trust (MET), New Delhi for Jharkhand candidates on 25th Sep. 2011. 20 candidates appeared in one day PSI and out of these 7 candidates were finally selected for IDB Scholarship 2011-12 Session.
4. 12th Convocation of both the computer institutes i.e, SCTGC, Bariatu and SIIT, Kantatoli was organized on 17th April 2011 at Gossner Theological College Hall, Behind GEL Church in which 50 Nos. of students of CTTC, 48 nos. of students of NTTC & 53 nos. of students for CABA-MDTP courses were awarded Diploma Certificates.
5. The Chief Guest of the 12th Convocation was Shree Bandhu Tirkey, Former HRD Minister & MLA, Jharkhand and the function was presided over by Janab Dr. Ahmad Abdul Hai. Janab Dr. Anwar Ahmad Khan, Vice-Chancellor Ranchi University, Janab Dr. Firoz Ahmad Vice-Chancellor N.P. University, Shree P. Biswas, Regional Director, SITD, Bihar & Jharkhand and Janab Dr. Majid Alam, Director Alam Hospital & Research Centre, Ranchi were also present in the function as Guests of Honour.
6. The Secretary Trust was appointed as Regional Co-ordinator from 1st August 2011 by DOEACC & NCPUL for monitoring and smooth running of 6 centres of NCPUL in Jharkhand.
7. Total 190 Nos. of students got free Computer & IT books as well as Urdu books (2090 nos.) equivalent to Rs. 1,21,600 of SCTGC and SIIT, in the year 2011.
8. Trust distributed 7 Nos. of scholarship to MCA,MBA & BCA students from IGNOU and 23 nos. of Scholarship for M.A. B.A & Diploma courses of MANUU & SIIT from Merit cum Means & Post Matric Scholarship of Ministry of Minority Affairs(MMA), Govt. of India for the session 2010-11.The total amount under MMA scholarship distributed was Rs. 1,80,335/-. Apart from this Trust also

distributed worth Rs. 19,195/- as fee waive off among needy and financially weak students of SIIT & SCTGC.

9. In Kolkata the release of book “ Banda-e-Momin Ka Hath” published by the publication division of Trust was organized on 3rd April 2011 in collaboration with West Bengal State Momin Conference. The chief guest of the function was Jb. Sultan Ahmad Sb., Minister of Tourism, Govt. of India.
10. SIIT unit of the Trust was selected from DOEACC, Kolkata for the training of Jharkhand Panchayati Officials for Basic Computer Course (BCC). In this regard 41 Mukhiyas, Sarpanch and Gram Pradhan from Ranchi district were given training in SIIT Centre from 12-09-2011 to 17-09-2011.
11. Trust organized a Free Typhoid Vaccination camp for children in collaboration with IDB Graduate Association, Jharkhand chapter on 23rd Oct. 2011 at Madrasa Faizul Uloom, Patratoli, Kanke, Ranchi in which 275 children were given the typhoid vaccination. A team of 10 doctors joined this vaccination camp.
12. SIIT was entrusted to conduct the BCC Training Prog. for six districts by DOEACC, Kolkata. As a result the second batch of BCC Trg. Prog. was conducted for Panchayat officials of Bokaro, Hazaribagh & Simdega districts from 27th Feb to 3rd March 2012 in which total 111 panchayati officials were attended in the course. The 3rd batch of same training programme was organised by the SIIT for Giridih, Godda & Ranchi districts from 12th Mar.-17th March 2012 in which 104 participants attended the programme.
13. Another course of DOEACC i.e “Free computer courses for SC,ST & Minorities in Jharkhand” was given to SIIT to train 40 students each in Computer application, Linux Programming & Computer H/w & S/w courses. The courses are already running from 5th March 2012 in which total 109 students are registered in SIIT, Kantatoli Centre.
14. Ministry of Minority Affairs (MMA) has launched the Free Coaching Programme for Computer Education and for this purpose the ECIL-ECIT agency was selected by MMA, New Delhi. The ECIL-ECIT finally selected our SIIT unit for the Free Training of Minorities students for two courses i.e Advance Diploma in Software Technology (ADST) and Diploma in PC Hardware & Networking (DPCHN). Total 50 students (25 in each course) started Training from 1st Feb. 2012 with stipend of Rs. 1500/- for rural & Rs. 750/- for urban area students.
15. Founder Chairman Trust attended different programmes & functions of Banda-E-Momin Ka Hath” the book published by the Trust in Chennai & Mumbai from 31st Dec. to 17th Jan.
16. The SIIT unit of Trust finally got the DOEACC “O” level Accreditation for its CABA-MDTP course vide its Accr. No. “O” 2073 w.e.f. 14th Mar. till 13th Mar. 2015.
